Readiness to undertake routine repetitive research is an essential requirement for the post. At your interview you will be expected to demonstrate broad knowledge of environmental issues, an understanding of the idea of sustainable development and an idea of how companies can address these issues in their corporate strategies. This knowledge could have been gained through work or academic study. Experience of research or similar work on environmental issues and a more in-depth knowledge of a particular issue or sector may be an advantage.

Applicants should have a 2:2 degree or equivalent in an environmentally related subject.
